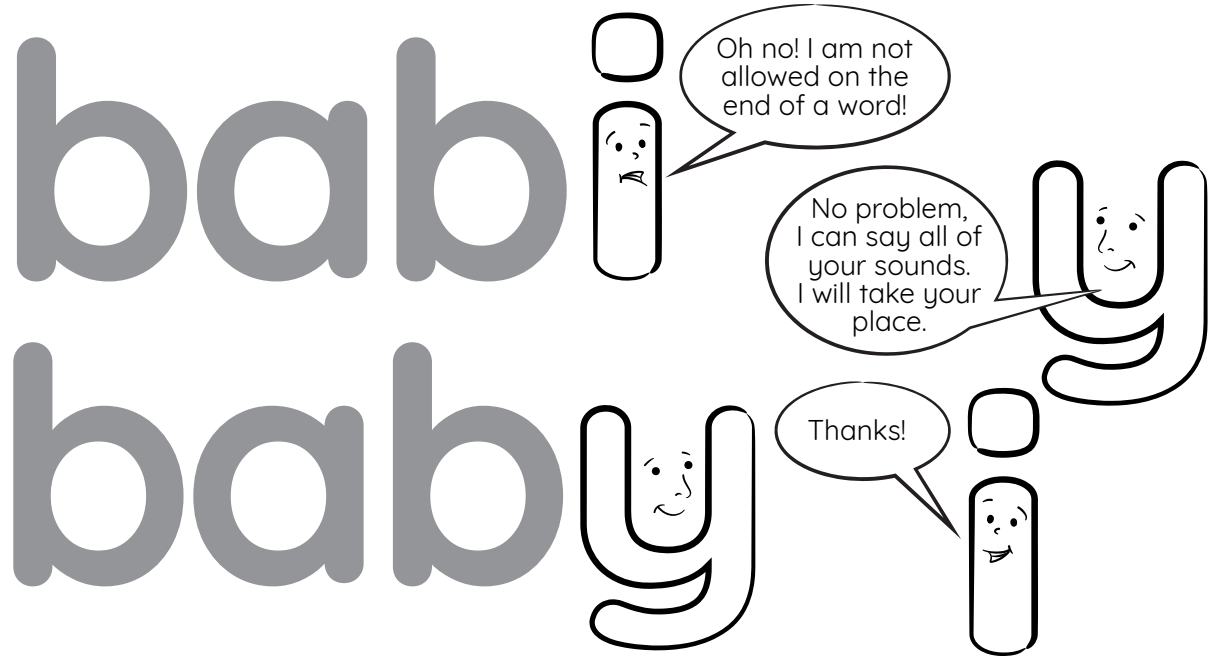
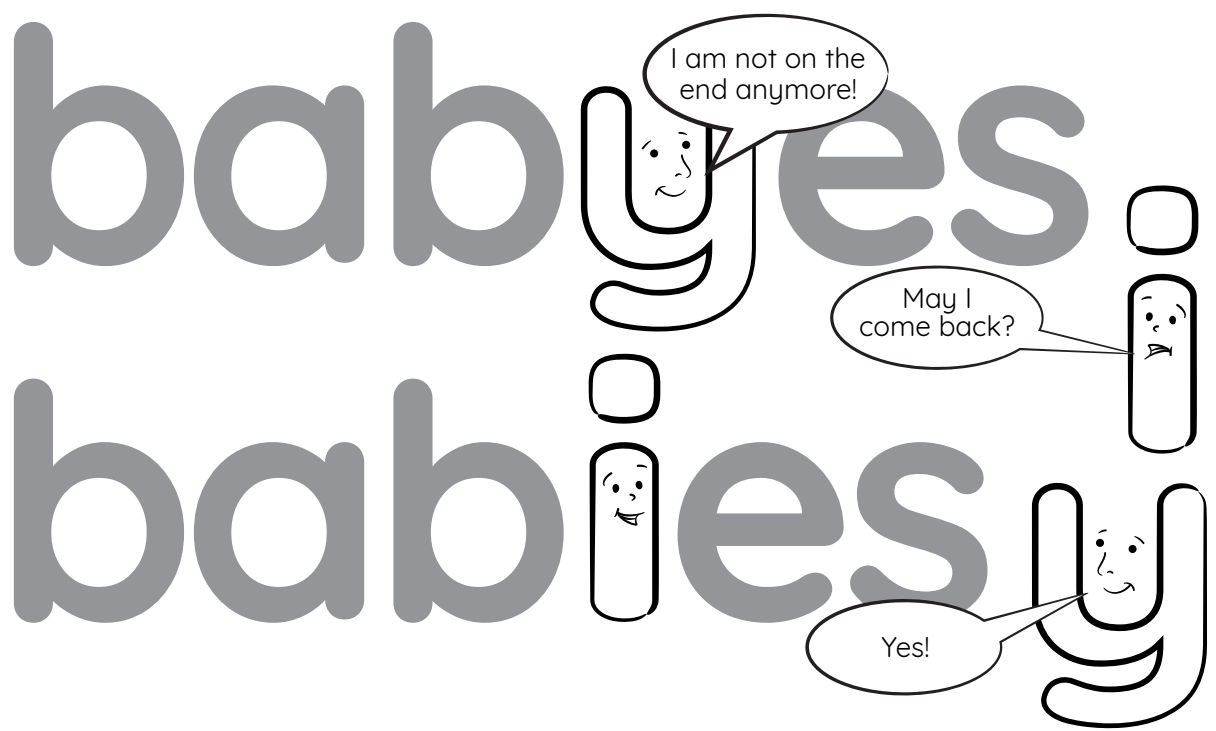


Change **y** to **i** rule

y can take the place of **i** (English words do not end with **i**).



But if a base word ends with **y** and we add any ending, the **i** can come back.



Change **y** to **i** rule

When **y** follows a consonant at the end of a word, change **y** to **i** when adding an ending other than **ing**.

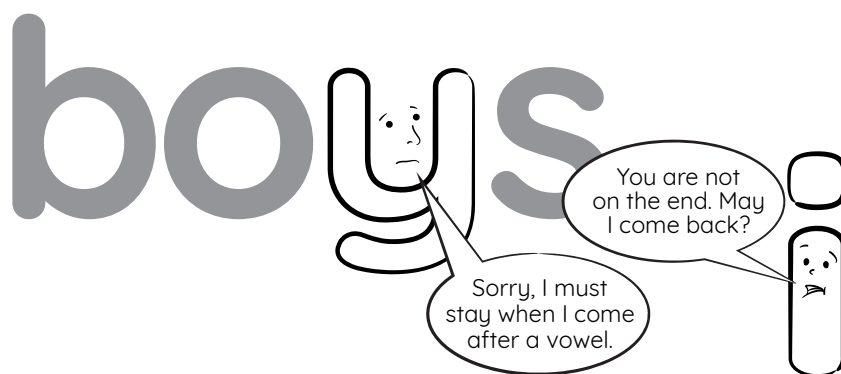
lady → ladies

carry → carried

cry → cries

city → cities

Do not use this rule when **y** follows a vowel...



...or when adding **ing**.
